

#### INTRODUCTION

Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education, (Declared as Deemed to be University U/S 3 of the UGC Act, 1956) Tumkur, was established vide MHRD GOI No. F.9-31/2006-U.3 (A) dated: 30/05/2008 of Govt. of India. The Academy started functioning w.e.f. 01/06/2008. Sri Siddhartha Medical College and Sri Siddhartha Dental College have been functioning as constituent colleges of Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education since 01/06/2008.

Further as per Govt. of India notification vide No. F.9-31/2006-U.3(A) Dtd. 16/12/2008, the UGC in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, included Sri Siddhartha Institute of Technology, Maralur, Tumkur, as an off-campus constituent teaching unit of Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education, Tumkur with effect from 06/03/2009.

Providing health care to patients and families living in rural India presents significant challenges, but comes with unique rewards. Keeping in view of growing shortage of Doctors and Health care facilities in rural areas, Siddhartha Academy of higher education (SSAHE) established a new medical college, Sri Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre at T.Begur, Nelemangala Taluk, Bangalore Rural District on 24/05/2019 in pursuit of offering quality medical education and commitment for holistic patient care, vide letter No. MCI-34(41)(E-22)/2019-Med/117067 dated: 24/05/2019.

On 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019, Medical Council of India recognized this as Medical College to offer MBBS programs and the first batch of students were admitted for academic year 2019-20, through NEET. This new Medical College is running in the name of Sri Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre (SSIMS&RC) at T.Begur.

It has a class infrastructure and dedicated proficient faculty on par with requirements of Medical Council of India. SSIMS&RC Hospital is dedicated to provide efficient but affordable medical services to the underprivileged population in its catchment area. The institute strives to deliver high quality; comprehensive, integrated, value based medical education including innovative approaches towards latest technology and research. This institution is the fertile land that nurtures budding doctors to become exemplary Indian Medical Graduates. A wide range of educational, technological, cultural, social and extra-curricular activities supported by state-of-art library and gymnasium, are available to students, faculty and staff.
