- To institute and award visitorships, fellowships, prizes, medals, stipends, and scholarships.

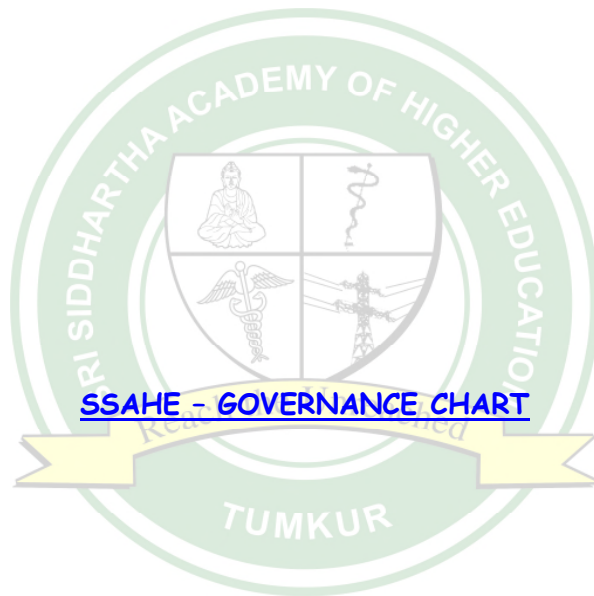

ADMISSIONS

It is mandatory, that the candidate has obtained not less than 50% in respect of Medical / Dental and in respect of Engineering courses not less than 45% of the aggregate marks or equivalent grade in the optional subjects in the qualifying examinations i.e., PUC II / 10+2 /HSC or equivalent. For SC/ST/OBC 40%.

POST GRADUATE COURSES -

The candidate seeking admission to these courses should have passed MBBS phase III/Final BDS examinations from the college recognized by **Medical Council/Dental Council of India/AICTE**

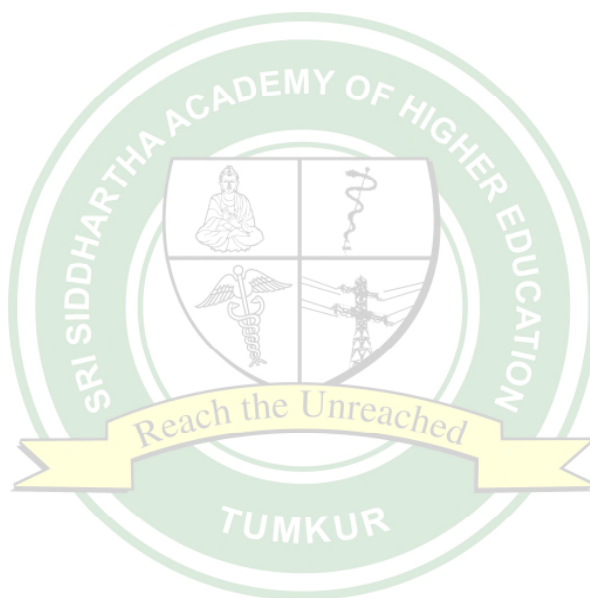

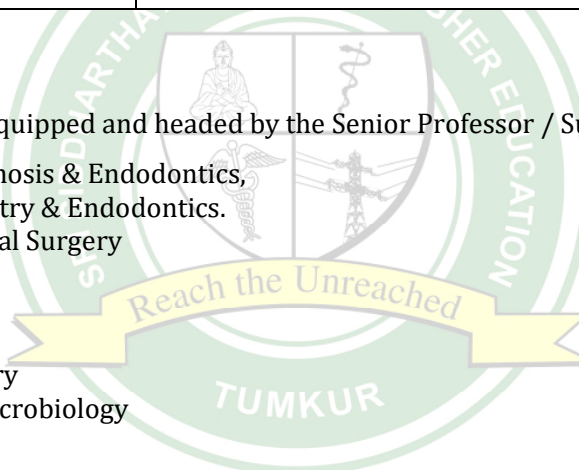


LIBRARY FACILITIES

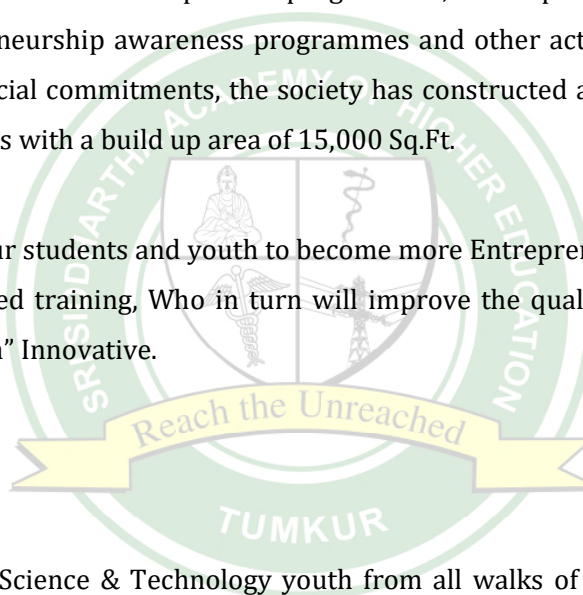

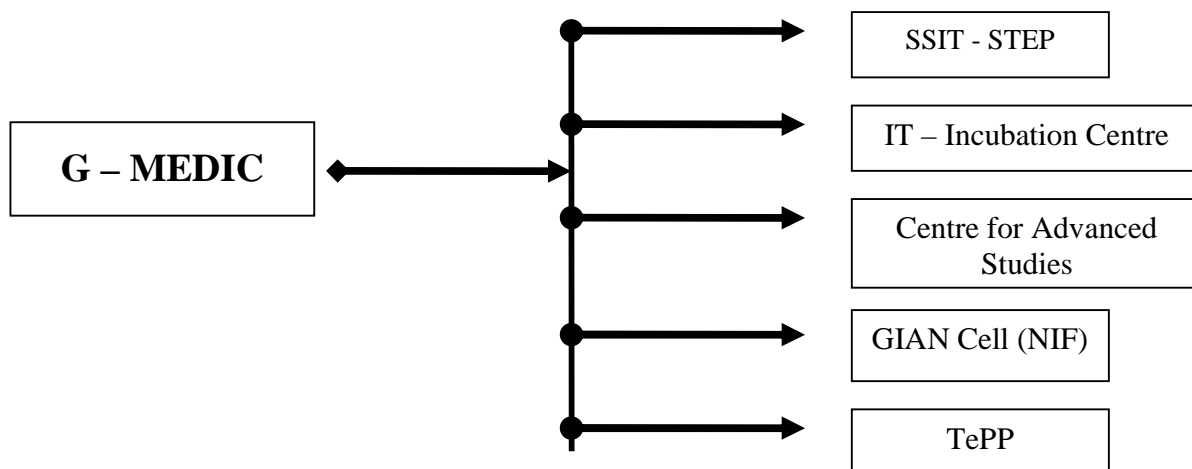
